# Passover

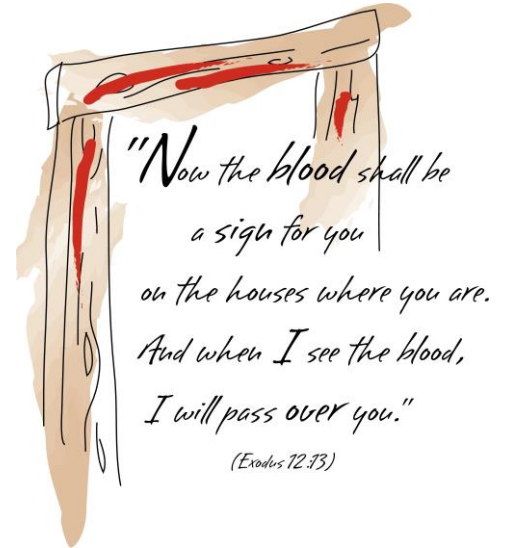
at the

Tuesday, April 2, 2024

Passover this year is April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024.

**We will be assembling at the LaPorte Church of Christ on April 2<sup>nd</sup> in the early evening, and ask you to join us.**

We will be live video-streaming to our website (like we do on Sunday mornings) the services from the Church at 7 p.m. mountain (8 p.m. central, and 9 p.m. eastern) on Tuesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>. We encourage you to gather with your family (and other families if available) and partake of Communion in the dark portion of evening on April 2<sup>nd</sup>.

If you cannot observe the Passover of the above date, the Law (Numbers 9:11) does allow the Passover to be kept the second month (May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024). The story, recorded in II Chronicles Chapter 30, tells of keeping it in the second month, and is a story worth reading. Should you read it, you will find it was a re-institution of it by the humble and sincere (II Chronicles 30:11). However, others laughed at, scorned and mocked it. In the story, those who kept it, preparing their hearts to seek God (II Chronicles 30:19), were blessed (verse 20).

It is this Ministry's prayer that the flock God has given them to minister to will keep this most important coming Passover.

Following are a few of Pastor Peters' notes and comments on the importance of keeping the Passover.

Even if you are not yet a Christian, i.e. not yet baptized (Acts 2:38), but plan to be, then take Communion on the Passover Day. It is that important. The Bible tells us our Israelite forefathers ate the Passover meal and THEN were baptized in the Red Sea.

*For I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea; and all ate the same spiritual food; and all drank the same spiritual drink, for they were drinking from a spiritual rock which followed them; and the rock was Christ.*

1 Corinthians 10:1-4

When they ate the Passover meal, they escaped the Wrath of God, poured out on the gods of Egypt in the way of a killer plague.

*'For I will go through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike down all the first-born in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments-- I am the LORD.*

Exodus 12:12

Though we presently suffer the diseases of Egypt (Deuteronomy 28:60), I don't think God has yet played His plague card that Habakkuk 3:5 speaks of.

*Before Him goes pestilence, And plague comes after Him.*

Habakkuk 3:5

There is a reason that this preacher teaches his flock to observe the Passover (as the early church did), and to keep the 91st Days, and to read the 91st Psalm on those days. *"No evil will befall you, Nor will any plague come near your tent."*

Psalm 91:10

Those days are to be calculated by the Solar calendar, using the lunar calendar. (Read our book Solar Sanity –vs– Lunar Lunacy in Calculating the Passover.)

**And remember, this day is so important that God has allowed for a make-up day (Numbers 9:11), which is May 2, 2024.**
