A Prayer for the Remnant, crying out in Repentance.

Forgive us Father, of all sin that may be in our lives, as we plead the blood of Jesus Christ over us and over this land!

We have been obedient to Your command and have kept the observance of the Passover, and in doing so we've entered in through the door. We've passed between the torn flesh and the blood and renewed our covenant with You. We've partaken of the Body and Blood, represented by the fruit of the vine and the bread in remembrance of You, LORD.

Heavenly Father, grant us a greater understanding, for how can we perceive anything so great as You and Your way? How can we fathom something so wonderful as Your love, Your grace, Your mercy, Your power and Your deliverance?

Your purpose for all of this is far beyond our understanding, but LORD, teach us so that we may walk in Your authority, for LORD we fully acknowledge that all power comes from You.

Give us the faith to understand Your promises, that Lord God in Heaven we do have those keys of the Kingdom given to us.

Matthew 16:19 I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Show us how to use them so we can bind the wicked on earth and loose those that have a heart to tear down Babylon. Open up Your Word to us. You created us to be a Kingdom and to be Priests unto You, Father; To serve and to worship You and You alone. How, oh LORD, can we serve You? For LORD, we are bound in our minds, bound in our flesh and bound by this Babylonian system.

Heavenly Father. You know the desires and the hearts of Your people, the Remnant! But LORD, our hearts still need perfecting to have that heart of flesh, as Jesus' was. Give us that heart that Jesus had, that heart for His people and for You, His Father, our God.

When they come there, they will remove all its detestable things and all its abominations from it. "And I will give them one heart and put a new spirit within them. And I will take the heart of stone out of their flesh and give them a heart of flesh, that they may walk in My statutes and keep My ordinances and do them. Then they will be My people, and I shall be their God.

Ezekiel 11:17-20

LORD Jesus, give us that heart of flesh. Put that new spirit in us.
